II. A road to westernisation: How to protect Indigenous cultures?

Indigenous cultures can be protected in different ways.

On the one hand, there are events such as Toronto's festival, which proves very popular by gathering many different people in this big city who want to embrace, represent or discover indigenous cultures.

This includes indigenous people who have a bond with these cultures, indigenous people who have lost their connections to them, non-indigenous people who are interested in them, as well as indigenous people with mixed origins.

It is also popular because it is organized in an urban environment which attracts more visitors than a traditional rural environment. But at the same time it promotes traditions in a peaceful and calm atmosphere. This makes the festival unique.

On the other hand, there are methods such as those used by *A Tribe Called Red*. They decided to defend their heritage and, at the same time, open it to a wider audience by mixing traditional music (with drums and dancers) and club music (with breakers). In the end, they share their native culture by adapting it to western, non-indigenous culture.
