The photo frame is held by someone so it must be a document that tells their story.

When you read the caption of the photo, two expressions are important: "US immigration" and "Angel Island". So, these two characters (or at least one of them) probably emigrated to the US and went to a place called Angel Island.

d. When he arrived in America in 1939 with his grandfather, Don Lee was 11. He wanted to join his father who had already settled there. He was detained one month in Angel Island's Immigration Station. Between 1910 and 1940, about 1 million people from 90 countries went through the immigration station and most of them spent such a long time there and were treated so badly that they carved poems into the walls of their barracks to express their feelings. The Immigration Station closed in 1940 but was recently restored. Don Lee hopes such a restoration will urge people and the authorities to treat today's immigrants respectfully.

This document is a video about a place called Angel Island where Chinese immigrants were greeted a long time ago.

Angel Island was one of the US immigration stations. It was a place where newcomers were processed before entering the US. Chinese immigrants were detained on Angel Island to prove their identity.

Don Lee was one of them. He landed there with his grandfather. He wanted to join his father who had arrived in America earlier. But going through this immigration station was an intimidating experience.

Indeed, there were medical and moral examinations and sometimes immigrants were detained for weeks, months or even years. Living conditions were appalling (*épouvantable*): for instance, there was no intimacy (*intimité*) as dormitories were overcrowded. Most newcomers had lost everything when they arrived in America and they did not even know if they would be accepted. Fortunately, Don Lee was allowed in and became an American citizen.
